



## Photography Competition 2019

### Terms and Conditions of Entry

1. The Organiser of the Isles of Scilly 2019 Photographic Competition is the Islands' Tourism and Business Partnership (IP), Destination Management Company for Visit Isles of Scilly
2. **No more than 2 images can be entered per category by each photographer.**
3. All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not have been previously published, nor must they infringe the rights of any other party. The entrants must be the sole owner of copyright in all photographs entered.
4. If anyone under the age of 18 features in entered photographs you must ensure that you obtain written consent of that individual's parent or guardian. Written consent must also be obtained from any individuals aged 18 or over who are identifiable in the photograph. It is your responsibility to ensure written consent is obtained and a copy submitted with entry.
5. Entrants under 16 must obtain permission on the Entry Form from their parent or guardian.
6. Entries must be provided in a digital format, either on disc / USB stick or by email. (Minimum resolution 300dpi, minimum file size 3MB).
7. Entries should be emailed to [enquiries@islandspartnership.co.uk](mailto:enquiries@islandspartnership.co.uk) and include the Category Title, Image Title and Name of Photographer (e.g. WildScilly\_ShrewsAtHome\_JoeBloggs.jpeg) no later than 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019.
8. By submitting your photograph(s) for the competition, you agree to grant the Islands' Partnership the right to publish, free of charge, and to allow others to publish the photograph online and in all media as required. You are also agreeing to take part in any competition publicity if asked to do so.
9. Employees and Directors of the Islands' Partnership, Penzance Heliport Ltd and Tresco Estate plus their immediate families are not eligible to enter.
10. All images may be digitally enhanced to reduce spots and scratches, but not manipulated. Entrants can enhance the picture to make it brighter, clearer etc but cannot manipulate the content.
11. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. The Organiser reserves the right to change any aspect of the competition, at any time, without notice.

The prize is a 3-night break for two staying on Tresco Island in a One Bedroom Sea Gardens Cottage on Tresco on the Isles of Scilly on a Self Catering basis plus two return tickets to Scilly from Penzance by helicopter provided by Penzance Heliport Ltd, landing on either Tresco Island or St Mary's. The winner of the competition will be notified by email in November 2019. The prize must be redeemed before 30<sup>th</sup> October 2020 and is non-refundable and subject to availability. Parking in Penzance and any other extras are not included.
