



Annual Photography Competition 2022

Terms and Conditions of Entry

1. The Organiser of the Isles of Scilly 2022 Photography Competition is the Islands' Tourism and Business Partnership (IP), Destination Management Company for Visit Isles of Scilly
2. No more than 3 images can be entered per category by each photographer.
3. All entries must be the original work of the entrant **taken in 2022** and must not have been previously published, nor must they infringe the rights of any other party. The entrants must be the sole owner of copyright in all photographs entered.
4. If anyone under the age of 18 features in entered photographs you must ensure that you obtain written consent of that individual's parent or guardian. Written consent must also be obtained from any individuals aged 18 or over who are identifiable in the photograph. It is your responsibility to ensure written consent is obtained and a copy submitted with entry.
5. Entrants under 16 must obtain permission on the Entry Form from their parent or guardian.
6. Entries must be provided in a digital format. (Minimum resolution 10 mega pixels, minimum file size 3MB in JPEG format only).
7. Entries should be emailed to enquiries@islandspartnership.co.uk or sent via [WeTransfer](#) and include the Category Title, Image Title and Name of Photographer (e.g. IslandScapes_StAgneslighthouse_JoeBloggs.jpeg) no later than 30th September 2022.
8. By submitting your photograph(s) for the competition, you agree to grant the Islands' Partnership the right to publish, free of charge, and to allow associated third parties to publish the photograph online and in all media as required. You are also agreeing to take part in any competition publicity if asked to do so.
9. Employees and Directors of the Islands' Partnership, Penzance Helicopters and Tresco Estate plus their immediate families are not eligible to enter.
10. All images may be digitally enhanced to reduce spots and scratches, but not manipulated. Entrants can enhance the picture to make it brighter, clearer etc but cannot manipulate the content.
11. The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. The Organiser reserves the right to change any aspect of the competition, at any time, without notice.
14. The prize is a day trip for two to Tresco Island, flying with Penzance Helicopters, entry to Tresco Abbey Garden and lunch at The Ruin Beach Café or The New Inn. The winner of the competition will be notified by email in November 2022. The prize must be redeemed before 31st October 2023 and is non-refundable and is subject to availability. No other extras are not included.
